

New Kenkut 3 versus Safety Wrap Station by San Jamar

- Both use the same metal blade.
- Kenkut 3 offers an optional slide cutter for film which is widely accepted in the industry
- Safety Wrap is 25% larger in length and nearly 20% larger in height and width over the Kenkut 3
- Safety Wrap is using identical suction cups as used with the old Kenkut 2 which have been problematic and unreliable.
- Kenkut 3 can be washed in a high temperature dish machine
- Safety Wrap cannot fit into many single rack dish machines
- Kenkut 3 is much less complicated to load film and foil
- Safety Wrap does not have integrated blade storage as does Kenkut 3
- Kenkut 3 has significant “space” saving integrated handles for transportation.
- Kenkut 3 offers a broader customer base due to optional slide cutter, much smaller size, ease of use and looks much better
- Safety Wrap has a design issue that does not allow for adequate space to grab the film or foil from underneath at the end corners without bunching up the material, especially at normal operational speed, preventing a proper grasp to pull out
- Food labeling is not a universal function of all film/foil use. The integration of the Safety Wrap label dispenser complicates the wrapping needs of many end users who have separate label dispensers that are very simple and much smaller
- Kenkut 3 and Safety Wrap have NSF approval. Kenkut 3 is obviously easier to clean and has much less debris collection points than the Safety Wrap Station
- Both are wall mountable

Case Cube – a constant issue for available shelf space for the dealer/distributor.

Improvements of the Kenkut 3 over the Kenkut 2

- 100% finger access—easier to use and allows more flexibility to accommodate international sizes
- Choice of safety blade or slide cutter
- Improved non slip feet instead of problematic suction cups
- More attractive look for front of the house and open kitchens - sushi bars etc.
- Improved support for dowel rod
- Integrated blade storage
- Units will stack for storage – (not for when in use)
